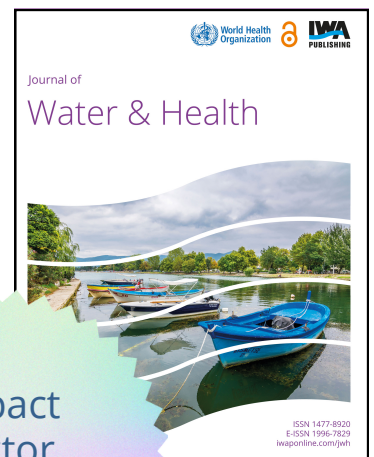
Wastewater-based Epidemiology
